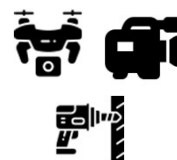

Devices in checked baggage must be completely switched off and protected from damage. The battery must remain in its compartment..

Carrying electronic devices in hand

Calculation of a battery's energy: $Wh = V \times Ah$

RESTRICTIONS ON USE IN THE CABIN



Powerbank

- ✓ Transport conditions apply equally to spare lithium batteries.
- ✗ Use prohibited onboard



Electronic cigarettes



- ✓ Powered off and secured in a protective case to prevent accidental activation.
- ✗ Use prohibited onboard

Defective electronic devices and damaged batteries are FORBIDDEN.



Lithium Batteries < 100 Wh

- ✓ Maximum of twenty (20) batteries allowed.

Lithium Batteries 100–160 Wh

- ✓ Maximum of two (2) batteries allowed.
- ✓ Prior approval from the Airline.

Lithium batteries must be individually protected in their retail packaging, in a plastic pouch or suitable case, or by covering the terminals with adhesive tape.

Lithium Batteries > 160 Wh

- ✗ Prohibited on passenger flights
