<p>TOILETRIES ARTICLES, MEDICINAL, AEROSOLS</p> <p>Toiletries articles or non-radioactive medicinal (including aerosols): hairspray, perfumes, colognes, nail polish and remover, and medicines containing alcohol Non-flammable non-toxic aerosols with no subsidiary risk for sporting and home use.</p> <p>Hair curlers containing hydrocarbon gas. Gas refills are not allowed.</p> <p>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES</p> <p>Beverages more than 24% but not exceeding 70% alcohol by volume. <i>As an indication: Alcoholic beers 1 to 15%, ciders 1 to 18%, wines 8 to 20%, and spirits from 15%.</i></p> <p>HOUSEHOLD, CLEANING AND HOME IMPROVEMENT PRODUCTS</p> <p>Paints, lacquers, varnishes, thinners, acetones, solvents, paint removers, pesticides, rodents, liquid or solid fuels, pool maintenance products, etc.*. ... whatever their type of packaging (aerosol, container, spray,)</p> <p>Energy-saving light bulb for personal and domestic use</p> <p>MATCHES, LIGHTERS, SMALL GAS CARTRIDGES REFILL</p> <p>Safety matches and small lighter. Aerosol valves must be protected by a cap or other suitable means to prevent inadvertent release of the contents.</p> <p>Up to 1 per passenger. The safety cover must be securely fitted over the heating element. Must not be used on board at any time.</p> <p>When in retail packagings and in receptacles not exceeding 5 Liters with a total net quantity per person of 5 Liters. <i>Note: Customs free-tax exemptions are generally more restrictive and must be taken in consideration.</i></p> <p><i>All products that may cause a risk to safety, health and to the environment and on which a hazard label is affixed. <p>Gas cartridges Small non-toxic non-flammable gas cylinders such as carbon dioxide (CO₂), or other suitable gas to operate small equipment: self-inflating device, food siphon, soda machine, air gun, etc ...</p>	Yes	Yes	<p>➤ <u>Prior approval is required</u> 4 small cartridges maximum per person. The water capacity of each cartridge must not exceed 50 ml / 28g. Nitrous oxide (N₂O) cartridges are prohibited.</p>
<p>SAFETY EQUIPMENT</p> <p>Life jacket and other self-inflating safety device operating with small non-flammable gas cartridges containing carbon dioxide or other suitable gases integrated into an inflatable auto device.</p>	Yes	Yes	<p>➤ <u>Prior approval is required</u></p> <p>1 individual safety device per passenger. Must be packaged in such a way that it can not be accidentally activated Maximum of 2 small cartridges included in the device; and 2 spare,</p>
<p>SECURITY-TYPE EQUIPMENT</p> <p>Security cases cash boxes, cash bag for valuable transport incorporating dangerous goods such as lithium batteries, or pyrotechnic material.</p>	No	No	Totally forbidden
<p>ENGINES AND SPARE PARTS</p> <p>Electric engine mains powered.</p> <p>Other engine operating with flammable liquid or gases and transported separately or integrated into equipment.</p> <p>Spare parts for vehicles or other motorized equipment that may contain hazardous chemicals, batteries, airbags, etc.</p>	Yes	Yes	
<p>TRANSPORT PACKAGING</p> <p>Empty containers that have contained a flammable liquid fuel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camping stoves • Jerrican, tank 	No	No	
<p>Insulated packagings or cryogenic container containing refrigerated liquid nitrogen</p>	Yes	Yes	<p>➤ <u>Prior approval is required</u></p> <p>Fully absorbed in porous material and containing only non-dangerous goods. The maximum gross weight of the packaging must not exceed 10 kg.</p>
<p>Packaging containing dry ice used to pack perishable goods not subject to the dangerous goods regulations</p>	Yes	Yes	<p>➤ <u>Prior approval is required</u></p> <p>The quantity must not exceed 2.5 kg per person when in checked baggage or in the cabin. Checked baggage must be marked «dry ice» and indicate the net weight of dry ice. The packaging should permit the release of carbon dioxide.</p>
